2003: Darfur

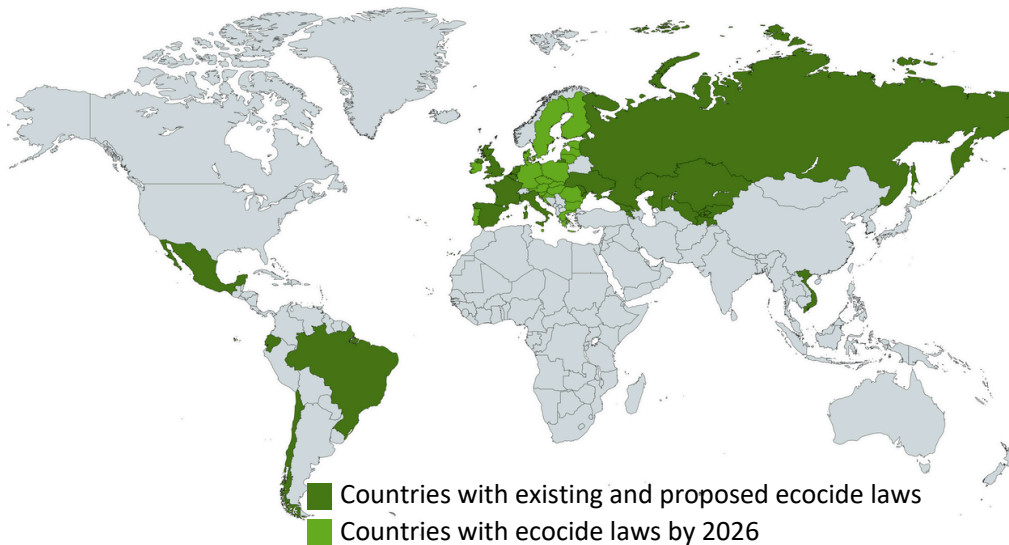
400,000 deaths
