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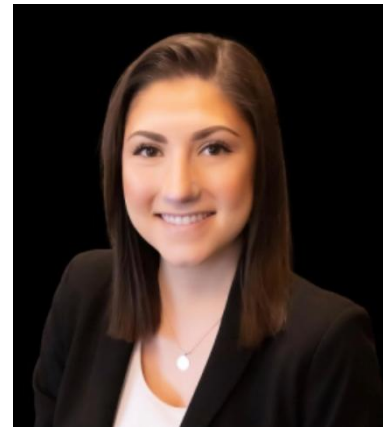
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World Without Genocide to Co-Sponsor International Justice Day in Rome, Italy

(Minneapolis, MN; July 14, 2026) On July 16-17, 2026, World Without Genocide will join organizations from around the world as a co-sponsor of International Justice Day in Rome, Italy, commemorating the anniversary of the adoption of the Rome Statute, the treaty that established the International Criminal Court. The event will bring together advocates, legal experts, civil society leaders, and policymakers to reaffirm their commitment to international justice, accountability, and the protection of human rights in the face of atrocity crimes.

The event includes a public rally on Thursday, July 16, at 6:00 pm (in Italy) in Piazzale Ugo La Malfa near the United Nations building, bringing together advocates and supporters to demonstrate global commitment to international justice and accountability. A press conference will follow on Friday, July 17, at 11:15 am (in Italy) at the David Sassoli Centre of the European Parliament in Piazza Venezia, featuring national parliamentarians, civil society leaders, and partner organizations.

Madeline Krehbiel Baskfield, Legal Associate, World Without Genocide, will deliver remarks on both days addressing international justice and in support of the International Criminal Court's critical work to uphold the rule of law, advance accountability, and provide justice for victims of atrocity crimes. Baskfield is a criminal defense attorney from Hennepin County, Minnesota. A graduate of Mitchell Hamline School of Law in St. Paul, her work has focused on defending the rights of individuals within the criminal legal system. She is currently based in London, where she is completing a Master of Laws degree in Human Rights, Conflict, and Justice at SOAS University of London. Her academic and professional interests center on human rights, justice, and the protection of fundamental freedoms.
