CONSTITUTIONAL RIGHTS

Non-citizens on U.S. soil have rights.

ICE agents violate amendments to the U.S. Constitution:

- **4th**: protects against unreasonable searches and seizures.
- **5th**: guarantees protections for individuals in legal proceedings.
- **10th**: reserves powers not granted to the federal government to the states or people.
- **14th**: guarantees citizenship, due process, and equal protection under the law.

Minnesota Constitutional Remedies Act

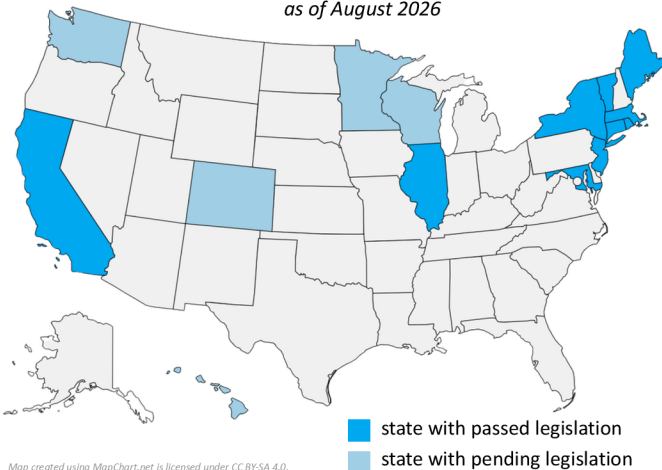
The **Minnesota Constitutional Remedies Act** was a 2026 proposal to enable Minnesota residents, regardless of citizenship status, to hold government actors liable for violating U.S. or Minnesota Constitutional rights.

The bill did not pass. **A new bill must be brought forward in the 2027 Legislature.**

States are passing bills to enable lawsuits against federal officers for violating the Constitution.
